"Oath of Office", for the Precinct level Public-Office of: "Justice of the Peace";

aka: "Precinct Captain".

I, the under-signed, do here-by solemnly Affirm, before all men, & before the Supreme-Judge of the Universe; that, to the best of my ability, I sincerely do intend to Responsibly & Faithfully Perform the Duties of a "Justice of the Peace", for the "Precinct Jurisdiction" here-under specified.

I recognize that my "Duties" here, include, but are not limited to, the following:

- **1:** I affirm that <u>I have a Duty to Administer "Justice</u>" in the Precinct level "Court of Justice", aka: "Court of Law", over which I preside. I affirm that this requires that I scrupulously follow <u>Constitutionally-recognizable "Due Process of Law"</u>, aka: "Due Course of Law", aka: the "Rules of the <u>Common Law</u>".
- **2:** Here-under; I affirm that my Duties to Administer Justice by Common-Law requires that <u>I</u> work in organic & symbiotic manners with each of the Town Constables of each of the Ten or less Township Jurisdictions that are functioning under the Judicial Authority of my Precinct-Court; & that I assist each of them in very frequently Assembling & Organizing Twelve-Person "Juries", who are to be composed of People who are Recognized among their own Township-level "Peers" as being of "Good & Lawful Character", & there-under as being "Qualified Electors".
- 3: I further here-under affirm, that, my Duties to Administer Justice by Common-Law requires that the "Juries" which I Assist our Town Constables in Assembling in our "Court of Justice", are to be assisted by me there-in, in their collective-efforts at Following the traditional & well-settled "Process" & "Course" of "Law" which is Required by the "Rules of the Common Law"; & that, here-under, each "Jury Verdict" which is forth-coming form the "Precinct Court" over which I preside, must be a "Unanimous Verdict", which is solemnly affirmed, in writing, with signatures & contact information, from each of the Twelve Jurists over which I have supervisory duties.
- 4: I further here-under affirm, that, my Duties to Administer Justice by Common-Law requires that I exercise "Vigilance" in Assisting Each of the Ten or less Town Constables under my Jurisdiction with their "Community Care-Taking Duties", in Each of the Townships over which they preside; & this where-under they Each have Full, Open, & Public Access to our "Precinct Court", at "Any Time" that they may make known to me that they have such a need; & that I will "Vigilantly" Maintain such "Open Lines of Communication" with Each of these Town Constables as is conducive with these Duties.
- 5: I further recognize that my Duties here also include conducting & presiding over <u>Regularly Scheduled Meetings of our "Court of Justice"</u>, aka: "Court of Law", all as is necessary in order to insure that Adequate "Justice" is Provided, so that the "Peace" in each of the Townships which make-up our Precinct is Vigilantly Maintained. I recognize that this will require that I Seek "Consensus" amongst all Ten or less of the "Town Constables" in our Precinct, concerning "Every Issue" of "Any Concern" which any among them may inform me as being a "Jurisdictional Problem" between their separate "Township Jurisdictions".
- **6:** I further recognize that I have a Duty to consistently <u>Defer to each of the Separate & Sovereign Jurisdictions of each of these Town Constables</u>; all so long as I remain reasonably convinced that

All Activities Occurring in their Jurisdictions are Occurring in "Peaceful Manners".

- 7: I recognize that I have a Duty to make Reasonable Efforts to Attend all County level Meetings, & this where-in I have the further Duty to respectfully & Vigilantly Seek "Consensus" on "All Matters of Mutual Concern" among each of the other Ten or less "Precinct Captains", aka" "JoP's" who collectively Share as Equals in Administering the Affairs of our "County Court", in our own separate & sovereign County Level Jurisdiction. I recognize that this includes the Maintenance of "Consensus" on all issues of "County Concern" amongst our Ten or less Precinct Captains; & this especially concerning Who from among us shall occupy our Leadership position, at our next higher-level of self-governing, as our own "County Judge". I also recognize that, Any One of our Precinct Captains have the Right & Duty to Call for a "Vote of Confidence" in our "County Judge", At Any Time that he might feel so Justified; & he may then & there propose that our Consensus should be Shifted to Another More-Qualified County-Judge/Leader.
- **8:** I recognize <u>that</u>, regarding <u>any & all "Precinct Issues"</u> <u>which I am not fully capable of resolving</u>, <u>I have a Duty to communicate these concerns</u> on up the chain-of-command, <u>to our "County Judge"</u>, so that he can exercise his larger Precinct-level jurisdictional authority, on our behalf.
- **9:** I further Recognize that <u>I have a Duty to our elected "County Judge</u>", <u>to promptly & Vigilantly Obey all Commands & Directives that he may Order me to carry out</u>; save only unless, in that instant, I am firmly convinced that such commands are "Un-Lawful". In any such instances as this, I will promptly give fully adequate explanation & justification for my Refusal of his Command, before all of our Precinct Captains, at our next County level meeting, if not sooner. I recognize that my Duties here are of most serious importance in the matter of <u>my Assisting our County Judge in the Selection & of Jurors</u> in all cases that might be brought before our County-Court Jurisdiction.
