MMRMA'S OBJECTIONS TO PLAINTIFF'S FIRST INTERROGATORIES AND REQUESTS FOR EXHIBITS

NOW COMES Defendant, MMRMRA, and for its Objections to Plaintiff's First

Interrogatories and Requests for Exhibits, states:

1. MMRMA objects to all of Plaintiff's introduction and commentary, to the

extent that it purports to impose any burden greater than Fed. R. Civ. P. 33 and/or 34.

2. MMRMA objects to Plaintiff's discovery requests for reason that they are

not yet permitted. Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(d)(1), "A party may not seek discovery

from any source before the parties have conferred as required by Rule 26(f), except in

a proceeding exempted from initial disclosure under Rule 26(a)(1)(B), or when

authorized by these rules, by stipulation, or by court order." Therefore, all discovery

requests are premature, as the required conference has not occurred.

3. MMRMA objects to Plaintiff's interrogatories as excessive in number.

Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 33(a)(1), the interrogatories are limited to 25, including

discrete subparts. Plaintiff has submitted 23 interrogatories to MMRMA, which each

must be answered separately for the years 2011-2016 (creating 138 interrogatories

total), well over the 25 interrogatories permitted.

4. MMRMA reserves all other objections until such time as discovery has

commenced and the requests are properly served within the time permitted for

discovery.
