Dear Mr. Schied:

This letter will acknowledge receipt of your recent correspondence, in wish you express the desire to make a criminal complaint against numerous police and judicial officers. You allege that there was a criminal conspiracy among these persons concerning a traffic ticket you were issued. You also claim damages in the amount of \$197,755,600.

I have reviewed the materials you submitted, but see no valid basis for the involvement of this office. Within the proper exercise of prosecutorial discretion, I am here denying your request for the initiation of criminal charges against the officer who issued you the ticket, the magistrate before whom you appeared, the Michigan Secretary of State and the others mentioned in your correspondence.

As for your desire to seek monetary damages, I suggest that you consult a licensed Michigan attorney for advice and assistance. The Attorney General represents State officers and officials on legal matters, and serves as a prosecutor in criminal cases. This office cannot advise or assist private individuals on personal claims. A licensed attorney will be able to advise you whether your claims are frivolous or if there is a proper basis to proceed on them.
