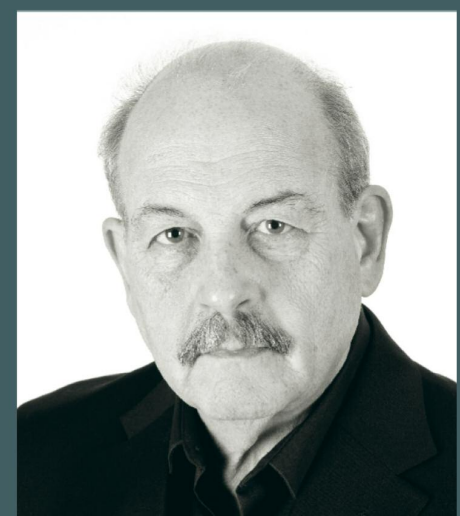

JUSTICE WEAVER'S 7-POINT PLAN FOR REFORM

(found in detail in Appendix A of Judicial Deceit)

1. End political party nomination of justices; candidates get on the ballot by petition.
2. Limit justices to a single term of a 14-year maximum (both election and appointment) combined with elimination of age limit of 70 years.
3. Establish a qualifications commission to begin the process of working with the Governor and the legislature to fill a vacancy on the court with a necessary appointment.
4. Require immediate and complete campaign financing reporting with complete transparency and accountability – every contributor individually identified.
5. Provide public funding for campaigns; use tax check-off money designated for gubernatorial campaigns.
6. Elect justices one-each from seven districts in the state – one every two years.
7. Eliminate unnecessary secrecy and require transparency in the business of the Michigan Supreme Court.
