Art. 14.01. Offence Within View.

(a) A Peace Officer

or Any Other Person,

May, without a warrant,

Arrest an offender

when the Offense is Committed

in his presence or Within His View,

if the offense is one classed as a felony

or as an Offense Against the Public Peace.

(b) <u>A Peace Officer May Arrest</u> an offender without a warrant <u>for Any Offense</u> committed in his presence or within his view.
