Section 418.151: Citizen Duties.

(a) <u>Each person in this state shall conduct himself and</u> keep and <u>manage his affairs</u> and property <u>in ways that</u> <u>will reasonably assist</u> and will not unreasonably detract from the ability of <u>the state and the public</u> successfully <u>to</u> <u>manage emergencies</u>.

<u>This obligation includes appropriate personal service</u> <u>and use</u> or restriction on the use <u>of property</u> in time of disaster.

(b) <u>This chapter neither increases nor</u> <u>decreases these obligations</u> <u>but recognizes their</u> <u>existence under</u> the constitution and statutes of this state and <u>the common law</u>.
