Sub-Chapter C. Protection of Persons:

Sec. 9.33. <u>Defense of Third Person</u>.

A person is Justified in Using Force or Deadly Force against another To Protect a Third Person If:

(1) under the circumstances as the actor Reasonably Believes them to be,

the Actor would be Justified

under Section 9.31 or 9.32

in Using Force or Deadly Force To Protect Himself

<u>against the Unlawful Force</u> or Unlawful Deadly Force <u>he Reasonably Believes to be</u> <u>Threatening the Third Person</u> he seeks to protect;

And

(2) <u>the actor Reasonably Believes</u> that <u>his Intervention is Immediately Necessary</u> To Protect the Third Person.
