## (1) A public servant, while acting or purporting to act in an official capacity

or taking advantage of such actual or purported capacity,

<u>commits official oppression</u> if.

with actual knowledge that his conduct is illegal, he:

(a) <u>Subjects another to arrest, detention, search, seizure, mistreatment, dispossession, assessment, or lien;</u>

or (b) <u>Has legal authority and jurisdiction of any person</u> legally <u>restrained of his liberty and denies the person</u> restrained the <u>reasonable opportunity to consult</u> in private with a licensed attorney-at-law, if there is no danger of imminent escape and the person in custody expresses a desire to consult with such attorney.

(2) Official oppression is a class 2 misdemeanor.
