<u>Every other Judicial Officer may, within the County</u>, City, District <u>or Precinct in which the judicial officer is chosen</u>:

(1) <u>Exercise the powers</u> mentioned <u>in ORS 1.260</u>.
(2) Exercise <u>Any Other Power</u> and perform any other duty <u>conferred</u> or imposed upon the judicial officer by statute.

The <u>Judges</u> of the Supreme Court, the Court of Appeals, the Oregon Tax Court and the circuit courts <u>have Power</u> in any part of the state:

(1) <u>To take and certify</u>:

(a) <u>The proof</u> and acknowledgment of a conveyance <u>of real property</u>, <u>or any</u> <u>other written instrument</u> authorized or required to be proved or acknowledged.

(b) The <u>acknowledgment of satisfaction of a judgment</u> in any court.

(c) <u>An affidavit or deposition</u> to be used in any court of justice or other tribunal of this state. ...
