**Warrant of Arrest: Issuance & Citation:**

If the Magistrate is Satisfied  
that There Is  
**Probable Cause**  
to Believe

that the Person has Committed the offense complained of,  
**the Magistrate,**  
if the offense is a Crime,  
**Shall Issue**  
**a Warrant of Arrest.**

However, on a misdemeanor charge or on a felony charge which in the discretion of the court may be considered a misdemeanor charge at the time sentence is imposed, the magistrate may authorize a peace officer to issue and serve a citation as provided in ORS 133.055. If the offense is a violation, the magistrate shall authorize a peace officer to issue and serve a citation as provided in ORS 133.055.
