If the Magistrate is Satisfied that There Is

Probable Cause

to Believe

that the Person has Committed the offense complained of,

the Magistrate,

if the offense is a Crime,

Shall Issue a Warrant of Arrest.

However, on a misdemeanor charge or on a felony charge which in the discretion of the court may be considered a misdemeanor charge at the time sentence is imposed, the <u>magistrate</u> may authorize a peace officer to issue and serve a citation as provided in ORS 133.055. If the offense is a violation, the magistrate shall authorize a peace officer to issue and serve a citation as provided in ORS 133.055.
