(2) Official misconduct in the first degree is a Class A misdemeanor.

162.415: Official misconduct in the first degree.

(1) A <u>public servant commits the crime of official misconduct</u> in the first degree <u>if with intent to</u> obtain a benefit or to <u>harm another</u>:

(a) The <u>public servant knowingly fails to perform a duty</u> imposed upon the public servant by law or one <u>clearly inherent in the nature of</u> <u>office; or</u>

(b) The public servant knowingly performs an act constituting an unauthorized exercise in official duties.

(2) Official misconduct in the first degree is a <u>Class A misdemeanor</u>.
