An Action at Law may be maintained in the Name of the State,

upon the information of the district attorney, or

upon the Relation of a Private Party

against the person offending, in the following cases:

- (1) When Any Person Usurps, Intrudes into, or
 Un-Lawfully Holds or Exercises Any Public Office,
 civil or military, or any franchise within this state, or Any Office in a
 Corporation either public or private, created or formed
 by or under the authority of this state; or,
- (2) When Any Public Officer, civil or military,

 Does or Suffers an Act which,

 By the provisions of Law, makes a

 Forfeiture of the Office of the Public Officer;

or,

(3) When any association or number of persons acts within this state, as a corporation, without being duly incorporated.
