The actions provided for in ORS 30.510 (Action for usurpation of office or franchise, forfeiture of office or failure to incorporate) to ORS 30.640 (Enforcement of judgment) shall be commenced and prosecuted by the district attorney of the district where the same are triable.

#### When the Action is upon the Relation of a Private Party,

as allowed in ORS 30.510

(Action for usurpation of office or franchise, forfeiture of office or failure to incorporate)

# the Pleadings on behalf of the State Shall be Signed by the Relator As If the Relator were the Plaintiff,

or otherwise as provided in ORCP 17; in all other cases the pleadings shall be signed by the district attorney in like manner or otherwise as provided in ORCP 17.

When an action can only be commenced by leave, as provided in ORS 30.580 (Action to annul corporate existence on leave of court),

the <u>leave shall be granted when it appears by affidavit</u> that <u>the acts or omissions</u> <u>specified</u> in that section <u>have been done or suffered by the corporation</u>.

## When an Action is Commenced on the Information of a Private Person,
